APPRECIATION FOR RESCUE OF 09 CREW **EX-MSV ANNAI VAILANKANNE AROCKIA VENNILA**

1. MRCC Chennai had received distress alert (Nature of Distress – Sinking) from 'MSV Annai Vailankanne Arockia Vennila' with 09 crew onboard, in position 06 deg 20 min North 076 deg 40.8 min East on 05 Oct 2021. Thus, a SAR operation was launched by MRCC Chennai for saving these lives at sea.
2. Accordingly, National Search and Rescue Services were activated and EGC message transmitted on International Safety Net (ISN) for intimating vessels transiting through the area.
3. MV MCP SALZBURG (IMO – 9383481) responded to the ISN message and establish prompt communication with MRCC Chennai leading to saving of 09 precious lives at sea.
4. During the entire operation, the master Captain Gavrylin Yuriy and all crew member onboard, were very supportive and prompt in communication, their actions were, as envisaged by MRCC Chennai. The entire operation was undertaken by MV MCP SALZBURG (IMO – 9383481) in coordination with MRCC Chennai and safely disembarked all 09 crew, rescued at sea, at Male port, Maldives.
5. Maritime Rescue Co-ordination Centre, Chennai, India acknowledges the contribution of MV MCP SALZBURG (IMO – 9383481) and conveys its appreciation to the master Captain Gavrylin Yuriy and all crew member for their assistance rendered during the entire operation.
